

Toledo Alexander Moss 4-H Scholarship Guidelines for Bell County Residents

School Year 2025-2026

The guidelines for the selection of the Toledo Alexander Moss 4-H scholarship recipient is set forth in the following rules:

- 1. Applicant must be a resident of Bell County.
- 2. Recipients must attend the University of Kentucky.
- 3. There will be one scholarship of \$500.00 to use toward payment of school expenses.
- 4. A letter from the University of Kentucky stating that the recipient is enrolled and attending classes, should be sent to the Bell County Extension Office. Scholarship money will then be sent to the recipient by the Bell County 4-H Council Treasurer.
- 5. The student must take at least 12 hours of classes in order to be eligible for the scholarship and may apply annually. (This is not available for summer school)
- 6. A second and third place will be selected in the event the first selection is unable to attend school.
- 7. Selection of the recipient will be made by the Bell County 4-H Council. If in the committee's opinion there is no suitable candidate, the scholarship will not be given.
- 8. Interested students should have applications in the Bell County Extension Office before or on Friday, April 18, 2025. No applications will be accepted after the deadline.
- 9. All applications are kept confidential.

10. Applications will be judged on the following criteria: Financial Need 50%

Potential/Character 25% Involvement in 4-H 25%
